During the year fourteen retirement grant requests were made by members of the community resulting in the payment of £200 per person being made to each of the recipients.

Over the year there were three grants made to students in higher education, each receiving a £200 grant.

Four funeral grants of £500 each were made during the year.

The Creeting Saint Mary Welfare Charities took part in the History weekend covering the last one hundred years of the charitable trust which had its origins in October 1619.

The aims of the Creeting Saint Mary Welfare Charities are featured in the bi-monthly Village Newsletter.
